Sociedad de Cafe de Altura de Cofradia de Chocolon (CALDIO) was established as a society on November 30th, 2010 in the community of Cofradia de Chocolon. By focusing on quality coffee CALDIO has provided better and more stable coffee prices to its producing members.

Associates of CALDIO gather weekly in the town hall, where the organisation also maintains a small office. Additionally, CALDIO owns and operates the El Pantano wet mill, located just outside of town where the president is Sr. Alfredo Pulido Soto.

Basilio de Dios del Cuarenteño (BASILIO) are located in the town of El Cuarenteño.

The stability in price that BASILIO offers its 33 members is highly beneficial to this family-run organisation. Due to climate change, crop production can be relatively unstable from year to year, fluctuating from a low of 50,000 kg of production to a high of 150,000 kg since 2013. However, by producing coffee of the highest quality BASILIO members are accessing a more stable and profitable market.
